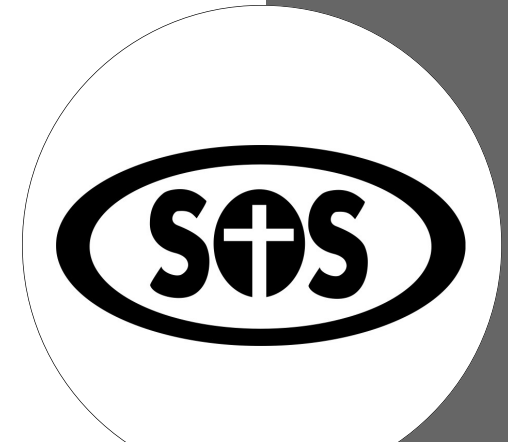
What?

SOS (Service Over Self) has been serving the impoverished area of Memphis since its inception in 1986. According to its website, "SOS now partners with several local churches and recruits hundreds of churches from all over the country to participate in one of our many mission camps. In its 25 year history over 20,000 SOS volunteers have repaired more than 700 homes." SOS has traditionally worked in the Binghamton neighborhood in Memphis but has expanded to begin work sites in the Orange Mound community in the past few years. What Will We Do At SOS?

Our primary work at SOS will be home repair for persons living in the Orange Mound community of Memphis. Home repair includes a wide variety of projects depending on the need of the individual's house whom we are serving. SOS has well-trained and capable staff members who will accompany our teams to our work sites, work alongside us, and give us guidance as needed.

In addition to our time on our work sites, we will spend evenings together enjoying dinner, evening sessions, worship, and free time. We will also have time on Wednesday afternoon/evening for time out on the town to explore all of the culture that the city of Memphis has to offer.

I Want To Go! How Do I Sign Up?

Registering for SOS is simple. Just fill out the registration form found in this brochure, cut along the dotted line, and return the form along with a \$100 deposit to Krislyn Durham. **The deadline for registration is February 16, 2012.**

The total cost of the trip will be \$245. You will be notified of due dates for the remaining balance payments once registration is finalized and as we get closer to trip time.

Space for this trip is limited. We only have 16-18 spots available for youth so sign up today. Trip spots will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Depending on how many adult members of our church sign up, further spots may become available.
