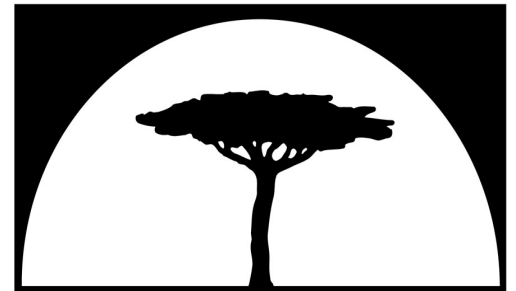

This Sunday, Mrs. Angella Current-Felder, will share an update about Africa University during the Sunday School hour in the Sanctuary. Her presentation will begin at 9:45 a.m. Mrs. Current-Felder is a member of the Africa University Board of Directors. Africa University was founded by the United Methodist Church in 1992 and has grown to be a transformational force in the African continent. It was the first recognized private university in Zimbabwe. At Africa University, undergraduate and graduate degrees as well as short courses are offered in areas such as agriculture, business and public administration, education, health sciences, the humanities and social sciences, peace, leadership and governance and theology. The University's total full-time enrolment is around 1200 students each year. Our congregation supports the mission and ministry of Africa University through our Apportionment giving each year.

This survey of the testament looks at how the early church took ownership of and was shaped by the story of Jesus and how the church learned how to develop as disciples and create communities of faith.
